
Musculoskeletal Examination



Musculoskeletal diseases affect a large proportion of the population. It is estimated that one in four visits to primary care physicians are related to these problems. In Canada, one in every six adults is affected, a figure that rises to 40% after age 65. In the coming decades, the number of cases is likely to rise in proportion to the increasing life expectancy. As the leading cause of work disability in a number industrialized countries and the main cause of long-term disability in all age groups, arthritis comes with significant economic social burden. Musculoskeletal and diseases compromise patients functional abilities with approximately one-third of adults affected claiming to have physical limitations that restrict their daily activities.
